IX. PRACTICE DESCRIPTION

The present-day Falvello Law Firm, P.C. had its origins in the initiation of the practice of law in downtown Hazleton, Pennsylvania, by Conrad A. Falvello in 1923. He was joined in the practice several years later by his brother, Rocco C. Falvello. Conrad's son, Anthony C. Falvello, joined the practice upon his graduation from Dickinson School of Law in 1953.

Conrad, Rocco and their brother, James J. Falvello (a dentist) were sons of an Italian immigrant. They grew up in an orphanage in West Hazleton and were self-educated and self-made individuals. Brother, James, attended Temple University and Temple University School of Dentistry, and he also practiced in downtown Hazleton for many years.

Rocco passed away in 1963. Conrad died in 1967. In 1974, Conrad's grandson, Conrad A. Falvello, joined his father, Anthony, in the practice of law in downtown Hazleton with the law firm of Falvello, Ustynoski, Giuliani & Bernstein. The firm disbanded at the end of 1977. Anthony and Conrad relocated to the firm's present location in June of 1978 in the Conyngham-Drums Valley outside of Hazleton and have been located there ever since. In May of 2005, Conrad's daughter, Alexis C. Falvello, became the fourth-generation lawyer to graduate from the Penn State/Dickinson School of Law. She is currently practicing in Pittsburgh.

Over the years, the Falvello Law Firm has committed its practice to the representation of everyday people injured or otherwise harmed through no fault of their own. The practice is truly a "blue collar" practice helping people in need of legal recourse who need legal representation and financial recovery for themselves and their families. Without such representation, they truly would be innocent, uncompensated victims.

The firm has also committed itself as much as possible to community service. Anthony served as Hazleton School District Solicitor for 13 years; as Hazleton Area School Authority Solicitor for 8 years; and as Sugarloaf Township Solicitor for nearly 20 years. Conrad has served as Black Creek Township Solicitor for 18 years; Solicitor for the Register of Wills of Luzerne County for 8 years; Assistant Solicitor for the Hazleton Area School District for 3 years; Solicitor for the Butler Township Zoning Hearing Board for 4 years; and more recently, Solicitor for the City of Hazleton for 6 years.

Both Conrad and Anthony have also served on numerous community boards and organizations.

Members of the Firm along with members of the Falvello Family have also endowed two scholarships at the Pennsylvania State University/Dickinson School of Law; and one scholarship at the Pennsylvania State University, Hazleton Campus.
